

12-week HALO Support Group begins Tuesday, February 4, 2025

HALO (Healing after a loss by overdose), is a support program offered by the Center for Grief and Healing at Hinds Hospice. We know that losing a loved one to a drug-related death impacts a family deeply and the feelings of isolation that grievers can experience.

The HALO program is currently offering a parent-specific support group on Tuesday evenings. Our goal is to create a safe and supportive environment where parents can experience their grief and connect with other parents who have experienced a similar loss. We also have grief support groups for children and teens.

Closed HALO Group (for parents only), space is limited and advanced registration is required.

The next session will begin Tuesday, February 4, and will be held Tuesday night for 12 weeks from 6:30—7:30 p.m.

Open HALO Group, no advanced registration needed, and no fee to attend.

Drop-in sessions are open to anyone impacted by a drug overdose loss and will be available one time a month on the 2nd Thursday of the month from 6:30—8 p.m.

Both closed and open sessions will be held at the Hinds Hospice Patient and Family Services Center 2490 W. Shaw Ave., Fresno, CA 93711
